Strike Hardship Fund

- Someone has to be a member for 3 months before claiming strike pay and will have to be in serious need of the money. In order to claim from the Strike Hardship Fund a confidential online questionnaire must be completed by the claimant so that the branch treasurer may determine eligibility for the strike hardship fund.
- The person will need to be able to prove they did not work, and the local rep will need to confirm their attendance at the relevant protest/picket line.
- The fund will pay at Living Wage, but depending on circumstances/budget, claimants can be offered 100%, 75% or 50% pay as the Treasurer deems appropriate.
- It is at the treasurer's discretion who qualifies for strike pay on a case by case basis and it is not guaranteed to all applicants. Receiving strike pay once does not guarantee that it will be received again in the future as the Treasurer will approve strike pay based on lots of factors such as how much money is available in the fund and how many other people are claiming strike pay.
